- x Installation and testing of more than 70 groundwater wells
- x Extraction and treatment of groundwater and soil vapor from the former Ketema Site and the adjacent Magnolia Elementary School
- x Application of a compound to directly break down and destroy chemicals in the water
- x Indoor air testing at the Ketema Site, Magnolia Elementary School and nearby residences and mitigating
